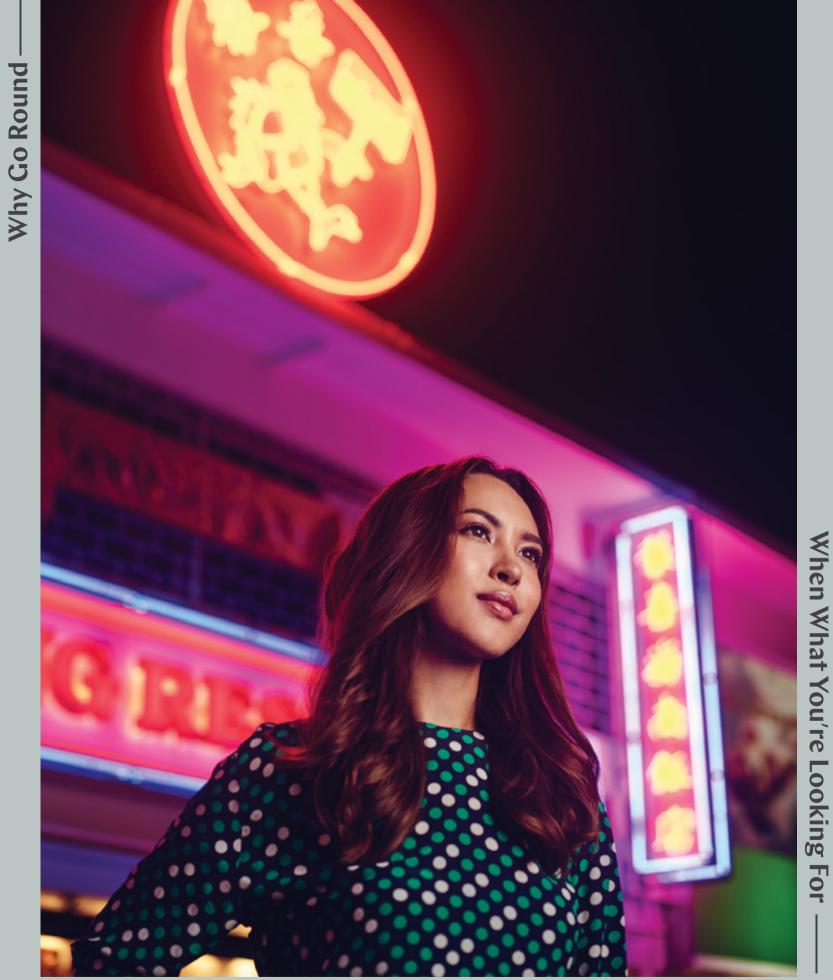

SPOTLIGHT ON SERANGOON GARDENS

Mention Serangoon, and Serangoon Gardens is probably the first to come to mind. The charming low-rise area is steadfastly laidback, way before slow-living even became a thing.

Developed in the 1950s by a Royal Air Force engineer, which explains the distinctly British names of the streets, Serangoon Gardens stands as a reminder of the past. Here people took their time to savour life's simple pleasures — and they still do.



Standing proud against the march of time are structures like the **post office** and police post as well as the iconic circus. These are virtually untouched since the 1950s, and even more remarkably, are still in use.



Another unchanged landmark is the Church of St Francis
Xavier. Inaugurated in 1959, it continues to serve the neighbourhood.



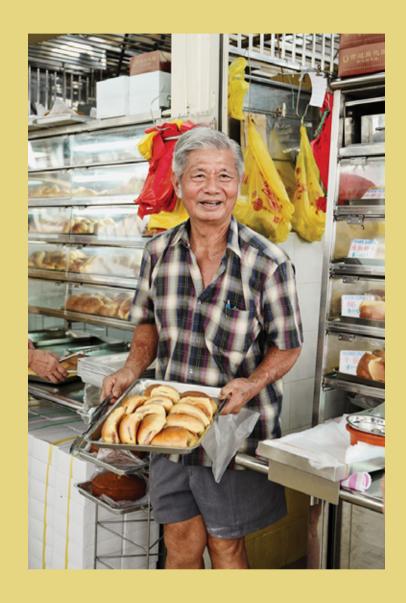
While they may be home to new restaurants and hipster cafes, the **shophouses along Kensington Park Road** look pretty much like how they looked in the 1960s, thanks to conservation measures to preserve the identity of this unique enclave.
