2 We fully understand and agree that from this date onwards, we will have no further claim to the flat application/booked flat and will comply with administrative measures that are applicable under the HDB's prevailing policy. We also understand and agree that upon cancellation of our flat application, we will forfeit the option fee/an amount equivalent to FIVE percent (5%) of the purchase price (whichever applicable).

3 We understand and agree that if we have been given an Additional Housing Grant (AHG)/Special Housing Grant (SHG), we will have to return the AHG/SHG amount (with accrued interest) to the HDB.

4 We would like to authorise the HDB to apply to IRAS to a refund of the paid stamp fees on our behalf. As for the conveyancing fee, we are aware that there will be no refund as it has been expended for the conveyancing services provided by HDB (if applicable).

5 We understand and accept that the above request is irrevocable. We hereby authorise HDB to waive the 21 days notification period for the cancellation with immediate effect.

6 We understand and agree that upon cancellation of our flat application, we and all the essential members in the flat application will have to wait out a one-year period before we can submit another application:

- to buy a subsidised flat from the HDB;
- to buy a resale flat with a CPF Housing Grant (including an Additional CPF Housing Grant);
- to buy a Design, Build & Sell Scheme (DBSS) flat or an Executive Condominium (EC) unit from a private developer (with or without CPF Housing Grant);

- d) to buy a resale flat that has been announced for Selective En-bloc Redevelopment Scheme; or to take over an existing subsidised flat by way of an outright transfer.

The one-year wait out period will start from the date of cancellation of the flat application.
